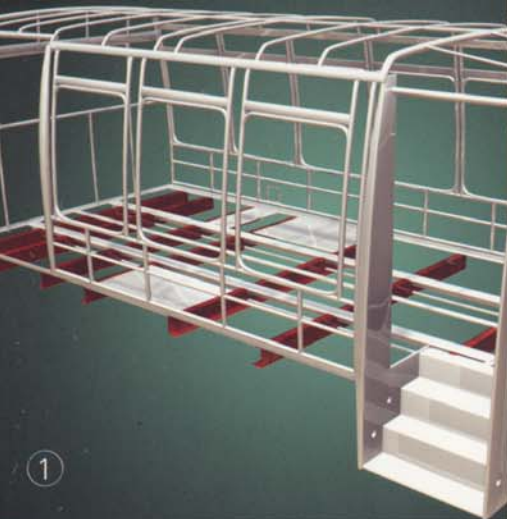

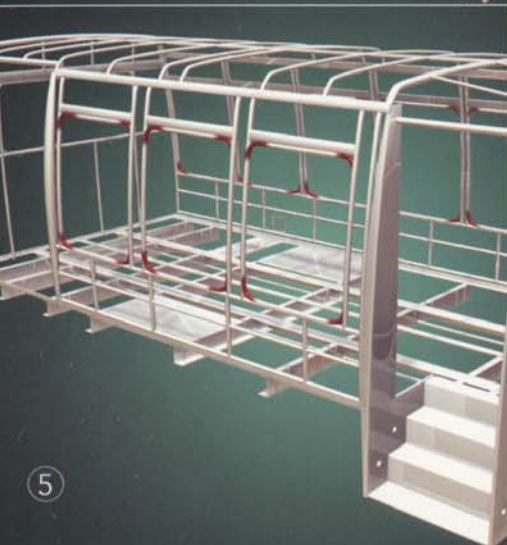

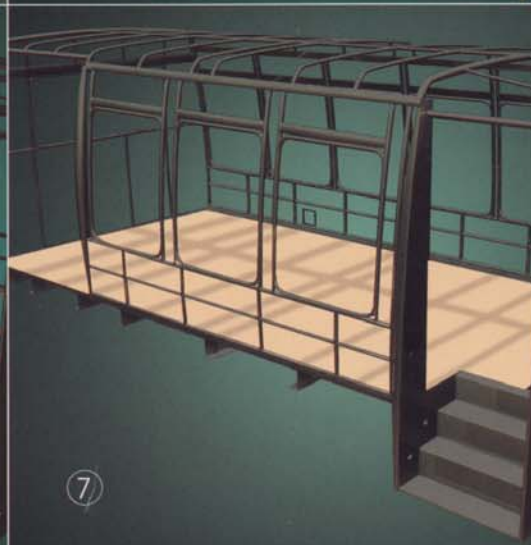

1 Turtle Top builds the strongest floor in the industry starting with G-channel cross members that stretch from wall to wall.

2 A full perimeter frame completes the floor to stand up to years of performance.

3 Center aisle stiffeners consisting of reverse cap steel C-channel prevents the aisle from sagging after years of operation.

4 Seat tracks mounted on reverse cap steel C-channels have been tested and certified to exceed DOT Standards.

5 Steel corner window gussets add perimeter sidewall strength and create a solid built frame for the windows that prevents window sags and water leaks.

6 Fully-primed roll cage is painted before construction begins.

7 Advantech® floor is secured with adhesive and mechanical fasteners for no squeaks or movement.

8 The sidewalls and ceiling are insulated by a closed-cell stiff foam that will not sag or allow moisture to penetrate for long-life protection from the weather and sound deadening.
